


Apply for a Nights Away Permit

These instructions should work on a laptop/PC. They're probably very similar for phone this process has been written for laptop.

1. Open www.scouts.org.uk
2. Click on **My Membership**
3. On the left-hand side, click on **Programme Support**
4. Click on **Permits**
5. Click on **My Active Permits**
6. Click on **Start new permit**
7. Search for **Nights away**
8. Click on the hyperlink that says **Nights Away**
9. Click **apply**
10. The form will open. Fill it in.

There are three main types of permit

- Indoor: Buildings with built in lighting and cooking facilities, indoor flushable toilets and access to running water.
- Campsite: Camping in tents, with access to flushable toilets and running water.
- Greenfield: Camping in tents with no indoor toilets and no running water on site.

There's also a lightweight expedition permit, but you probably aren't applying for that.

Restrictions

You are not asking for any restrictions. Restrictions are more relevant to other permit types (e.g. a canoeing permit may have a safety restriction of no more than 8 paddlers and max wind speed of Beaufort 4).

Assessor

Please put choose the internal assessor Aaron King – If you click on **Full name** twice it sorts alphabetically by first name and you'll see Aaron on the page 1.

If you are applying for a greenfield permit, choose Jeremy JEZ Holmes - you may need to click through a few pages to find him.

If it asks you for this, a concise list is fine. Include:

For example:

- Beaver sleepover, Jun 26, 150th Wadsley HQ, 1 night, helped lead event.
- Cub Camp, Jul 25, Drum Hill Scout Camp, 3 nights, in catering team of 2 adults.
